OPERATION CHECKLIST

SECTION 1

OPERATOR/LESSEE MUST BE 21 WITH VALID DRIVERS LICENSE

VESSEL IS NOT PERMITTED TO OPERATE ON LAKE MICHIGAN; serious injury or death may occur to include capsizing and sinking vessel

A. LESSEE agrees not to use, nor permit the use:

1. of the leased vessel for any unlawful purpose
2. of the leased vessel in a careless, reckless, or negligent manner
3. of the leased vessel while under the influence of alcohol and/or narcotics
4. by any person who is not an authorized operator under this agreement

B. Reckless Operation of a vessel shall include but not be limited to:

1. weaving through congested traffic or unnecessarily close to a wake producing vessel
2. operating at greater than slow/no wake speed within 100ft of an anchored or moored vessel, shoreline, dock, pier, swim float, marked swim
3. operating contrary to navigation rules including following too closely to another vessel. "Following too closely" shall be construed as proceeding in a the same direction and operating at a speed in excess of 10mph within 100ft to the rear or 50ft to the side of another vessel which is underway, unless said vessels are operating in a narrow channel,.

SECTION 2

Use common sense and respect your fellow boaters

- a. No smoking on vessel
- b. Do not exceed the capacity of vessel; failure to comply could lead to sinking of the vessel, injury, and/or a moving violation.
- c. Keep your copy of this rental agreement with your leased vessel at all times; this is your proof of rental and registration.
- d. Do not operate vessel using engine in shallow waters (less than 3ft).
- e. Do not start the engine in shallow water (less than 3ft), manually move vessel until in to deeper water.
- f. Beaching the vessel under power is not permitted.
- g. Prior to Anchoring, use to the map to determine depth of water; use 3ft of rope for every foot of depth.
- h. When Anchoring, come to a stop, shut off engine, ensure rope (tackle) is secured to vessel, then lower anchor.
- i. Entering the water is at your own risk. Conduct Risk Assessment before entering.
- j. Before entering the water ensure engine is stopped 30 seconds prior to entering; this allows propeller time to stop.
- k. Stow ladder, account for passengers, raise and stow the anchor, and close and latch all gates.
- l. Be aware of other boaters, boats, skiers, tubers, and swimmers at all times, and keep 100ft from vessels and personnel.
- m. If you experience difficulty with your vessel you must notify KACBOATRENTALS immediately.
